EMI, ICLHE and Englishization: Reflecting on the changing university



The 7th ICLHE Conference takes place in less than five months at Maastricht University in the Netherlands. The Conference is mainly on site with four or five parallel thematic strands, but at least two strands will be live streamed for online participants.

As the theme indicates, the 2022 ICLHE Conference, *EMI, ICLHE and Englishization: Reflecting on the changing university*, explores the effects of English-medium instruction (EMI) and Englishization in general on academic identity, on the nature of knowledge and on the design and quality of teaching and learning. Contributions to the Conference also unravel ramifications, sometimes reciprocal, for other languages, for the status of a language as academic language, for the lifeworld of people, and for national and local cultural identity.

The conference is attracting not only scholars from around the world, but also non-academic stakeholders who both influence and are affected by the languages of education at university. Together we examine the impact of EMI on the university and society.
