The abstract submission deadline is July 31st. Please send an abstract to the editorial board (as an attachment) to jjclileitors@te-clil.jp.

Asian CLIL is an open access, peer-reviewed international academic journal, which is associated with Japan CLIL Pedagogy Association (J-CLIL) and annually published online at Asian CLIL website. The journal welcomes contributions on the following research themes: e.g., CLIL, CBLT, CBI, bilingual education, immersion, IB, integrated learning, CLIL classroom research, CLIL assessment, CLIL teacher education and other related areas. Authors are encouraged to submit original articles that report on practice of CLIL (Practical Report) and/or offer theoretical perspectives that contribute to fostering research on CLIL pedagogy in the local context (Research Articles). Asian CLIL aims to help implement and develop CLIL pedagogy in distinctive local educational contexts in Asia and beyond, increasing the diversity and flexibility of integrated learning.

Qualification to submit the paper:

- Members of J-CLIL who gave (or are scheduled to give) a presentation at a J-CLIL research meeting/seminar and/or an annual conference.
 - * Multiple authors: The first author must be a J-CLIL member. All authors are encouraged to become members after their manuscript is accepted.
 - * Those who are based outside of Japan are exempted from the qualification above but encouraged to become a member of J-CLIL.
- Those who are invited by the editorial board.

Important deadlines:

- Abstract submission deadline: July 31st, 2023
- Notification of acceptance: August 31st, 2023
- Paper submission deadline: November 30th, 2023

*Abstracts (approx. 300 words) must include title, author's name, and affiliation (see the template attached).

*Manuscripts should be 5,000 to 8,000 words, including notes and references.

*The authors will receive a decision after peer review.

Publication date:

The Asian CLIL will be published in spring 2024.

Submission guidelines:

The Asian CLIL primarily uses APA style (seventh edition).
